


PROJECT DESCRIPTION

A 3.8 km new underground railway, thereafter called "kowloon southern link" or ksl, would be constructed to connect the kcrc east TSIM Sha TSUI (TST) station to the West Rail (WR) Nam Cheong (NAC) station with its alignment under salisbury road, canton road and the west kowloon reclamation area to improve the accessibility to and lessen the traffic congestions at TST and west kowloon districts. The civil construction works for the ksl are splitinto three design and build contracts kdb200, kdb300 and kdb400.

SERVICES PROVIDED

FINAL DESIGN OF MINED UNDERGROUND STRUCTURE UNDERCROSSING CHERRY STREET USING FREEZING OR GROUTING OPTION WITH SCL PRIMARY SUPPORT AND EXCAVATION.
